GPSR COMPLIANCE: REMOVING THE COMPLEXITIES OF COMPLIANCE



ADD GPSR INFO TO YOUR LISTINGS

Online marketplaces require listings to include key safety, manufacturing, EU responsibility and compliance information.



APPOINT AN EU RESPONSIBLE PERSON

A designated Responsible Person, such as the manufacturer, importer, or an EU entity, must ensure GPSR compliance and manage corrective actions if needed.



PROVIDE CORRECT DOCUMENTATION

Documentation includes technical documents that prove EU safety compliance, and (if required) a Declaration of Conformity for CE-marked products.



ENSURE LABEL COMPLIANCE

Labels must display the manufacturer, product description, safety disclosures, and EU Responsible Person details, translated into each EU country's official language.

CONNECT YOUR INVENTORY

For certain products, you will be asked to provide certain additional data, information and documents.


REVIEW AND VALIDATE

Review data and, upon approval, the data will be pushed to your listings, or downloadable via a csv file.

For products where Webinterpret is the EU Responsible person, a Certificate of Conformity will be generated.

HOW TO REVIEW AND VALIDATE YOUR ITEMS




REVIEW

From your Webinterpret Dashboard, you can review the state of your inventory with GPSR Compliance. First, focus on your **Items to be validated** items (this will require the least amount of effort for validating the compliance of your items), and then on your **Missing information** items.

2 EDIT

Edit allows you to manually add missing information to your item. Editable fields on the item-level include *Country of Origin*, *CE marking*, *Safety warnings*, *Disposal instruction*, *Product composition*, and *Manufacturer*.



3 ASSIGN AN EU RESPONSIBLE PERSON


You can refer to the **Assessment** column which shows the number of conditions an item has fulfilled in order to assign Webinterpret as the EU Responsible Person. When items have a *red status*, review their full list of conditions and provide the requested missing information using **Upload** and **Edit**. A *not eligible status* means that Webinterpret cannot be assigned as the item's EU Responsible Person as its selling category is not supported. To validate your item, you must provide EU Responsible Person information.
